### Ground Transportation Info

The hotel is located 24 miles from **Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport (DFW)**. Hotel shuttle service is not provided.

**Taxi service** is available on the upper level of Terminals A, B, C and E, and on the lower level of Terminal D. An Airport Guest Assistant is available at taxi stands between 8:00 AM and midnight. After hours service can be scheduled by calling **972-973-4062**. **The estimated taxi fare one-way is \$61.** Uber and Lyft are also available in Dallas.

**SuperShuttle DFW** provides a shared ride for \$17 one-way. Go to [www.supershuttle.com](http://www.supershuttle.com) to schedule your ride.

**Self-parking** on-site is \$15 per day plus tax, which is a discounted rate for FSA/HI attendees. Valet parking is \$28 per day, not including tax.
